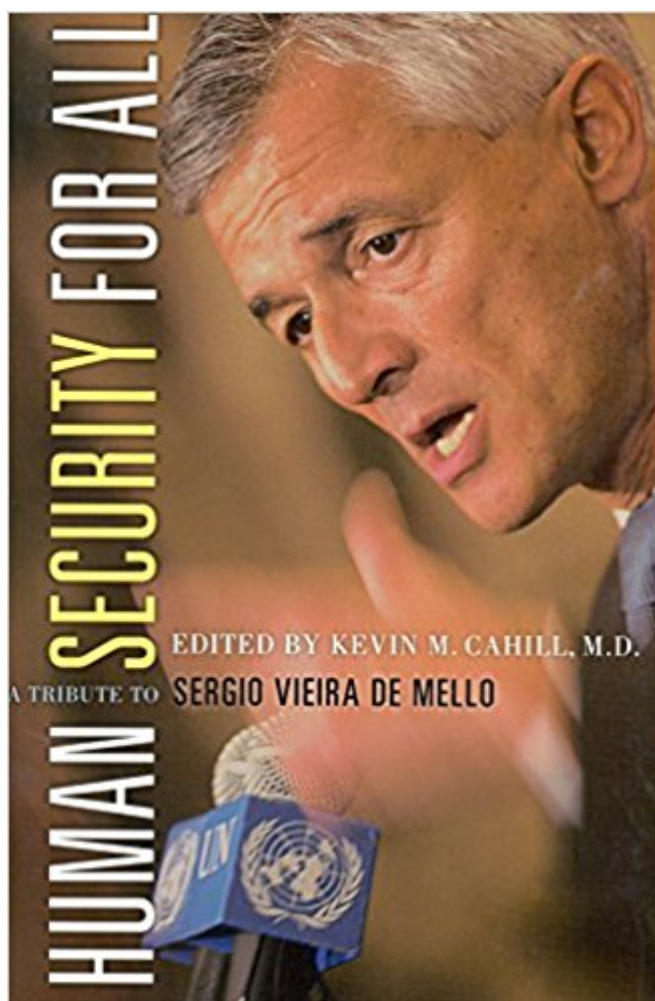


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Human Security For All: A Tribute To Sergio Vieira De Mello (International Humanitarian Affairs)
