

Blair and Dawn Witherington have authored books on sea turtles, Florida beaches, and seashells, and have worked together on a variety of natural history publications. Blair is a research scientist with a master's degree in biology and a doctorate in zoology. Dawn is a graphic designer and illustrator specializing in scientific and educational depictions of nature. Pineapple Press also published their popular Florida's Living Beaches.

This book was perfect for my needs. I live part time at the Outer Banks NC and needed a book to help me identify seashells. Most books cover the entire Atlantic coast . This covers all the locations I need. Its layout is easy and organized. I don't have to wade through exotic shells I will probably never find on my beach walks. I also frequent many other NC and SC beaches. They have also included bits of information about shells I did n't know about. Now I know why I have been finding these large black shells.

The pictures in this book are great and the descriptions as well. However, there is an error in the

book. The map key is wrong. In the book it states that the solid lines indicate "relatively common" and open lines "relatively uncommon" but the key shows and states the opposite. So..we weren't sure where to look for certain shells :( an error on a map key is a pretty big mistake, but the information on the shells is very nicely organized. Since we were using this as a tool to find and identify shells, I gave it a 2/5.

First, regarding CONTENT: Both this book, and their other book, "Our Sea Turtles" are excellent! However, Second, regarding USABILITY: I have to give them both a 1 or 2 stars at the most. Both books lock in horizontally and will NOT rotate as ALL my other books and magazines do on my Kindle, Vertically. These are the only two books I am having TROUBLE with. Needless to say, VERY frustrating. PLEASE FIX THIS ASAP and I will give it 5 stars (10 if I could)

This is a really nice little book, especially considering the price. I like to buy localized field guides because it's usually easier to find what I'm looking for in this type of book. I purchased several of these books for use in my lower school classroom and the kids love them! It's simple enough for 3rd grade to identify shells but has enough information for older students to do a little research as well. The photographs are very good and the text is not too technical. The book has good information and an interesting "did you know" section as well.
