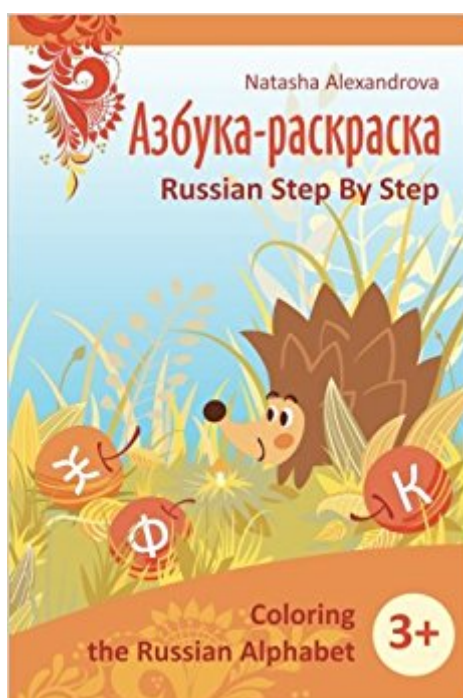

Natasha has been teaching Russian to foreigners for over 20 years, first in Ukraine and then in the USA. She has a Bachelor's in Linguistics and a Master's Degree. Natasha attended a number of teaching trainings, conferences and seminars. Before her career as an author Natasha was a head teacher and observed countless lessons, giving feedback to the teachers about how to improve the lesson, as well to the students on how to benefit the most from the program. Natasha watched many students struggle with learning Russian via complex textbooks that present a lot of material quickly and without allowing the student time to internalize the new information. She quickly started developing her own way of presenting the materials and realized that there is a very simple way to learn any language: just by dividing something complicated into simple pieces and mastering the language step-by-step. Her many years of work and experience culminated in a book series of her own - Russian Step by Step. These books are easy to follow and, at the same time, are teaching real Russian. In RSBS books students will find dialogues from everyday life, exercises to help

master those dialogues, and texts to help in remembering them. The series has two branches: adult and children's books. The adult series is aimed to non-Russian speakers who want to learn it for any reason by themselves or with a teacher. Many hours of audio that comes with the course books allow the student to pick up the correct Russian pronunciation. The children's series is aimed to bilingual kids or kids who are heritage learners and their parents/grandparents want them to be able to not only understand but communicate in Russian. The books take into consideration the specifics of this audience and make sure the kids have fun while learning. - See more at:

We glued stuff to the letters: sticks, stickers(just some we had around " tried to find things that started on that letter and then stuck them on) and playdough. The book recommends yarn, which we tried, but you need pretty good glue " with Elmer's glue the yarn kept moving around. We still have not covered all the books but will keep on going through the summer, so it's a good 5-10 minute activity (for one letter) for any boy who can not sit still for long!

My wife wanted to start introducing the Russian alphabet to our 3 y.o. daughter. So far we only covered the letters that make her name and although her coloring is not that great - she loved all the extra activities (especially the gluing of threads on the letters).We were not sure how much she will get from this book but after doing the activities with the letters she actually surprisingly remembers them all and is pointing at those letters in her Russian books.

Too expensive for what you receive - paper quality and art quality no better than what you would get by printing from online resources.

Expected more from this book. There is a large sized letter on each page and a suggestion to color or decorate it with yarn, etc. I expected to have more exercises, pictures to color. Save your money and print out your letter sheets for coloring from the internet.
