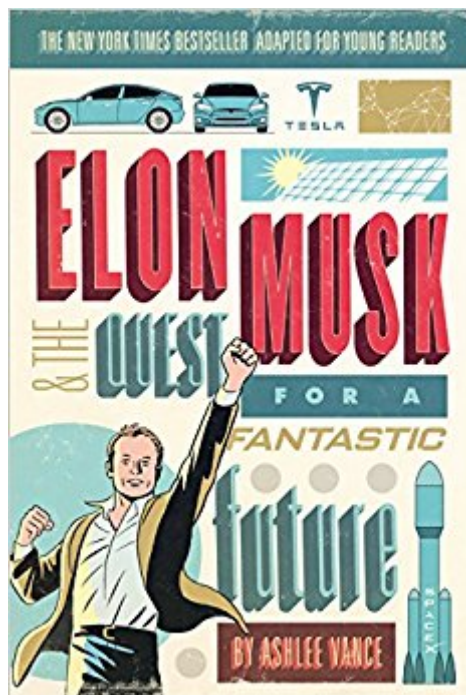




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Elon Musk And The Quest For A Fantastic Future Young Readers' Edition

My son has been inspired by this book. He really liked it!

I read the adult version a couple years ago. It was a great and inspirational book for anyone, but especially someone younger aspiring to be an entrepreneur. The main issue with the book is that you couldn’t really give it to a kid because it was riddled with F-bombs. It worked in the adult version because it gave you a sense of Musk’s sharp character, but obviously not something you would want someone in elementary school reading. I bought two of these—one for my niece and one for my nephew. I read through part of the first chapter and the adaptation seemed good. Some of the concepts seemed a little above an 8-year olds’ capacity, but I don’t have any kids that old yet, so I may be setting the bar too low. I will update with my niece and nephew’s impressions.

This is a young readers’ adaptation of the adult version book *Elon Musk: Tesla, SpaceX, and the Quest for a Fantastic Future* by the same author that came out in 2015. There are a lot of books on Elon Musk but the one by Ashlee Vance is the only one that gained exclusive interviews with Elon

Musk, his friends, family members and immediate associates. I enjoyed reading anything regarding Elon Musk, one of the most badass entrepreneurs of our time, and this book is perhaps the best read about him, his childhood in South Africa, his move to Canada, his early businesses and his current companies. Great insight into Elon Musk's life and a must read for young aspiring entrepreneurs...or for pretty much everyone even if you are not into entrepreneurship or business.

Summary: Brief-ish biography of Elon Musk that avoids hagiography by explaining the clean-energy mogul's colossal failures and some of his character flaws with a good amount of detail. Readers will get a sense of the risks that paid rewards for Elon Musk and a glimpse into how car, solar panel, and aerospace technologies work. Appeal: Rich people and fast toys are an easy sell for most teens. Most of the language and the pacing is intended for an ages 12 and up reader. I also learned that Elon is quite the videogamer and is known to beat his employees in shooter games like Counterstrike. My students will want Elon Musk to be their boss one day! Possible issues with comprehension: I want this book to be accessible to most middle and high school students, I really do, unfortunately the author skips over some of the basics like what it means for a company to go public and slips into unnecessary business-ese. An example from p. 167: "SpaceX can undercut its U.S. competitors -- Boeing, Lockheed Martin, Orbiting Sciences -- by a ridiculous margin. Why not just say 'make it more cheaply'?" A few diagrams and/or illustrations and descriptions of how doohickies work would have also improved this book from the STEM side. Curious and motivated readers can probably find additional information online to aid comprehension, but it's too bad there wasn't an easy resource within the text or with a glossary. Recommended for: Readers who enjoy technology and/or teaching readers how to skim, skip, and use a book for additional research online and in other texts.
