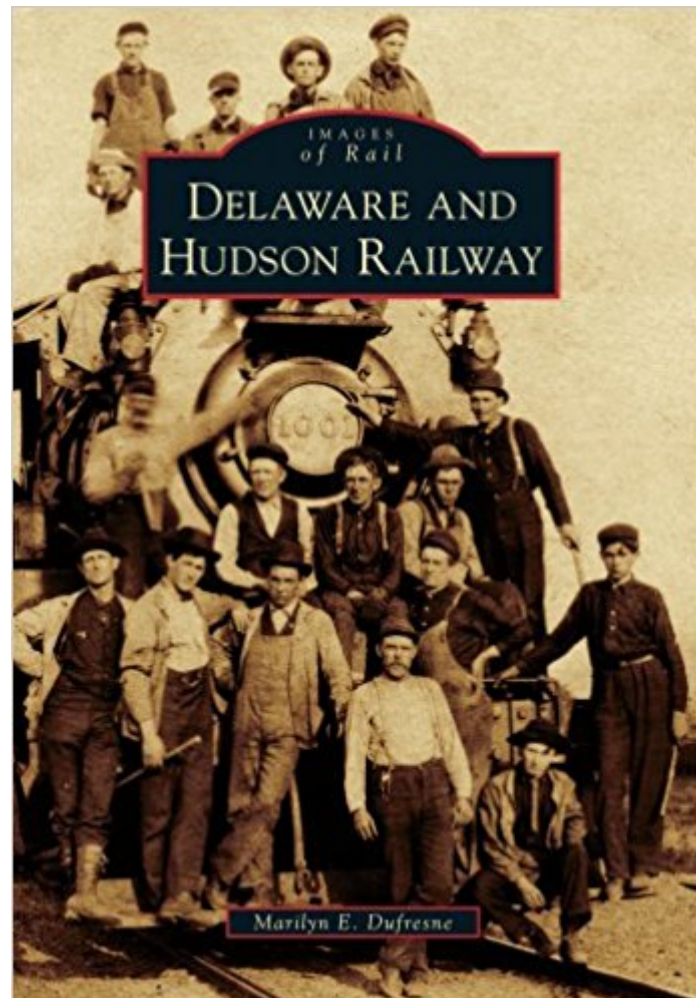

As usual for these books, mostly photos. But interesting. My wife's father and grandfather were employees, and a gang from their tiny home town is shown there, but not them. This is more people oriented than rolling-stock oriented, and that was fine with me as I have the other type already.

All in all an excellent book in this outstanding series called "Images of Rail"-as usual a lot of "missing dots" are supplied in the photo captions that are of interest to rail historians. The only complaint is that only the southern end is extremely well covered and the northern end is not covered-may a Volume 2 is in order.

This book is very informative and a must have for any Delaware and Hudson fan. It makes a great companion to the Delaware and Hudson Canal and Gravity Railroad book by the same publisher. Together they tell the story of a great American transportation system.

The book was written about areas in and around my hometown. A good read if you are a railroad buff (or a local)
