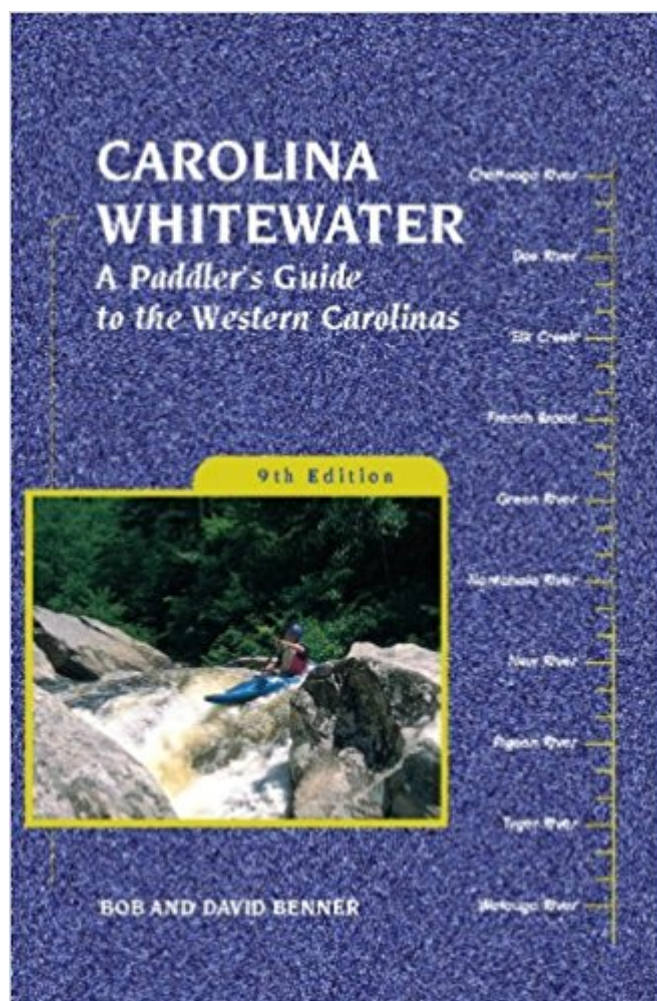


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Carolina Whitewater: A Paddler's Guide To The Western Carolinas (Canoe And Kayak Series)

River descriptions, shuttle and gauge information, and topographic-based maps complete the useful information needed to help boaters pick rivers to match their ability. With over 80 detailed profiles and more than 60 maps of the best canoeing and kayaking waterways in the Carolinas, this guide is indispensable. From quiet float trips on the French Broad to exciting runs on the fast-flowing Nolichucky, *Carolina Whitewater* details the best paddling experiences in both states.
