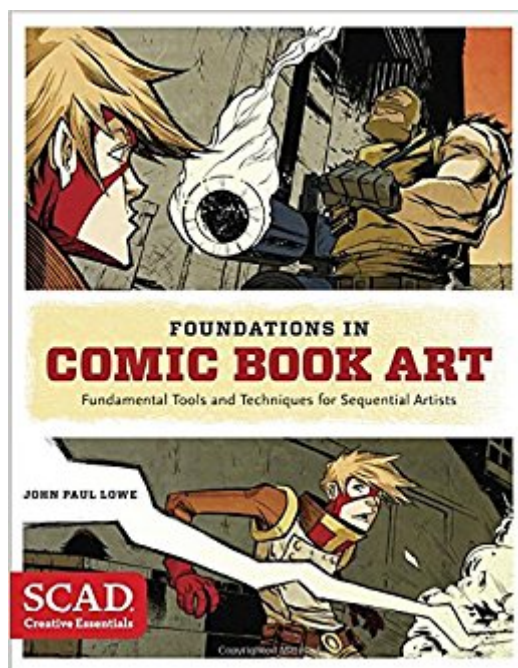

FOREWORD One of the saddest lessons you will learn when you go to art school is that your art is not very good. One day in sophomore year you will look down at your Dali-inspired colored pencil drawing of anthropomorphic lizards, and you won't be able to ignore it any longer.

You'll look up at your professor and see it in her eyes: she thinks you're a bad artist. She thinks you're a bad artist, and she doesn't think you're ever going to get better. "Very creative," she'll say. "Thanks," you'll say. John Lowe thinks you can get better. In fact, he's sure you can get better. He's sure you can get good. This is what makes John Lowe a great teacher and an unusual one. If you are his student, he is interested in you and he is interested in your art. He finds out what your goals are, and he doesn't let you forget them. He finds out what your comfort zone is, and he jabs and teases you out of it. He finds out what tools you're used to using, and he doesn't let you use them anymore. He finds out how much homework you're used to doing, and he assigns twice as much.
