I was a teen mom and can easily identify with the protagonist, Lianna Champion. I didn't endure the more painful aspects of her life, but I was ridiculed, teased and looked down upon by so many because I was an unmarried, pregnant, and a handicapped

teen. Lianna experienced some of the same but she also had wounds that went far deeper. Lianna, like many teen moms, remained strong even during her weakest and most vulnerable times. She had a trusting spirit and seemed to always see the good in others even when she was not treated so well. I live this story because it is not pumped up or exaggerated. It truly has an inspirational message that shows how the human spirit can persevere and accomplish great things even in the face of adversity. This book, in my opinion, will make a great book for teens in the school system. I can see it as Required Reading because it will bring about much to discuss. However, it is not just for teens. Adults would highly enjoy this book; I did.

It's easy for us to look at someone and judge them based on what we see without really knowing their true story. For young people this is extremely magnified because of the internet and the way people are quick to jump to conclusions based on decisions that were made. But what if there was more to the story than what we see? What if even though we've made bad choices or mistakes things can turn around for us? In *SOPHOMORE MORE* author LaCricia A'ngelle explores this and more through the main character Lianna. We're able to see how this young woman has to navigate not just loving herself but dealing with some painful events from her past that led her down a road of looking for love and attention in places where it wasn't real. Now a mother herself, will she be able to keep moving forward and pursuing her goals and dreams in spite of the obstacles and challenges she faces? Will she be able to get her mother to see that there was more going on that led her down the path she was now on? More importantly, will Lianna remember that in spite of everything she is going through that God loves her and will never leave her, no matter what others might do?
