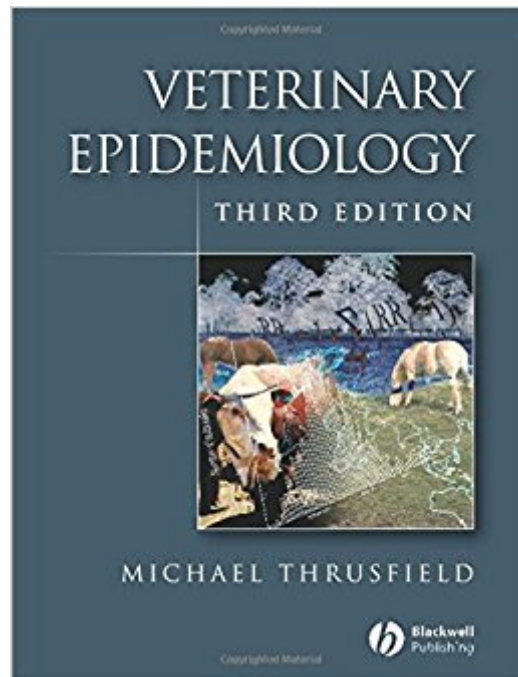




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Veterinary Epidemiology, Third Edition



Synopsis

This successful book, now in its third edition, continues to provide a comprehensive introduction to the role of epidemiology in veterinary medicine. Since the publication of the second edition there has been considerable expansion in the application of veterinary epidemiology: more quantitative methods are available, challenges such as the epidemic of foot-and-mouth disease in Europe in 2001 have required epidemiological investigation, and epidemiological analyses have taken on further importance with the emergence of evidence-based veterinary medicine. In this edition:

- Completely revised and expanded chapters;
- Increased attention given to the principles and concepts of epidemiology, surveillance, and diagnostic-test validation and performance;
- Many examples are drawn from both large and small animal medicine, and from the developing as well as the developed world.

This paperback edition includes a new section on risk analysis. *Veterinary Epidemiology* is an invaluable reference source for veterinary general practitioners, government veterinarians, agricultural economists and members of other disciplines interested in animal disease. It will also be essential reading for undergraduate and intermediate-level postgraduate students of epidemiology.
