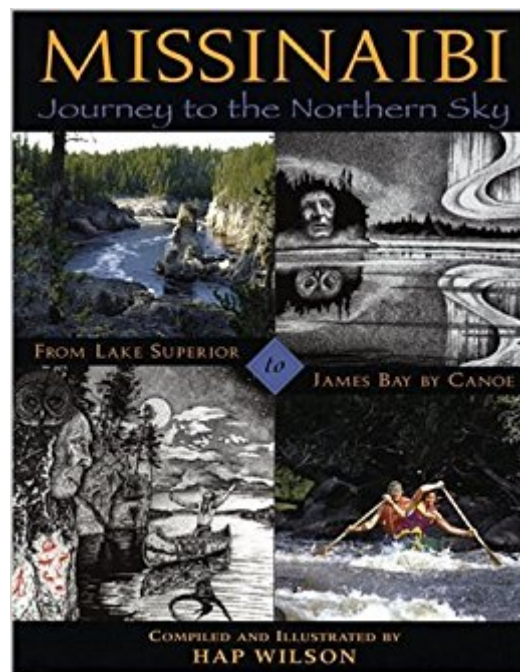

Prior to the release of the first edition guidebook in 1994, the difficulty of the river and the inaccuracy of the topographic maps led to the death of an average of 2-3 people every year. Since the release of the guidebook there have been no fatalities on the river. The detailed rapids drawings are classified according to the International River Grading System -- as all of our books adhere to. Also included in this guidebook is the Little Missinaibi River loop route -- a must see for those interested in Native lore and history.
