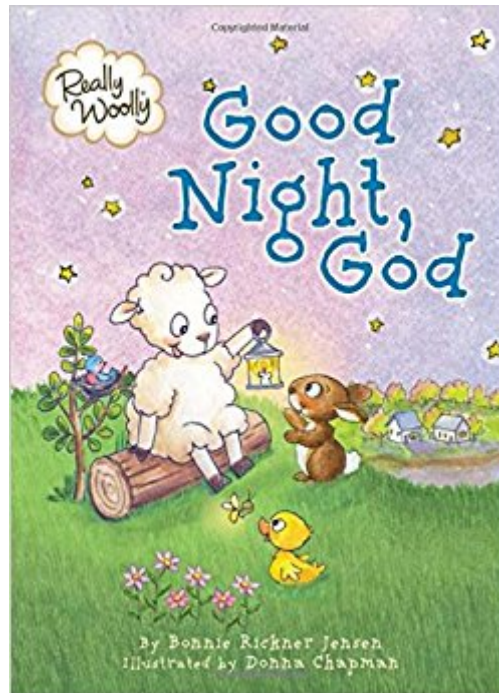

You can really use the poems to talk with older siblings about how the ideas relate to them. For example, with the prayer â€œGod Makes You Strong,â€• you can ask your child what makes him worry, and explain how God protects him from things that cause fear.
