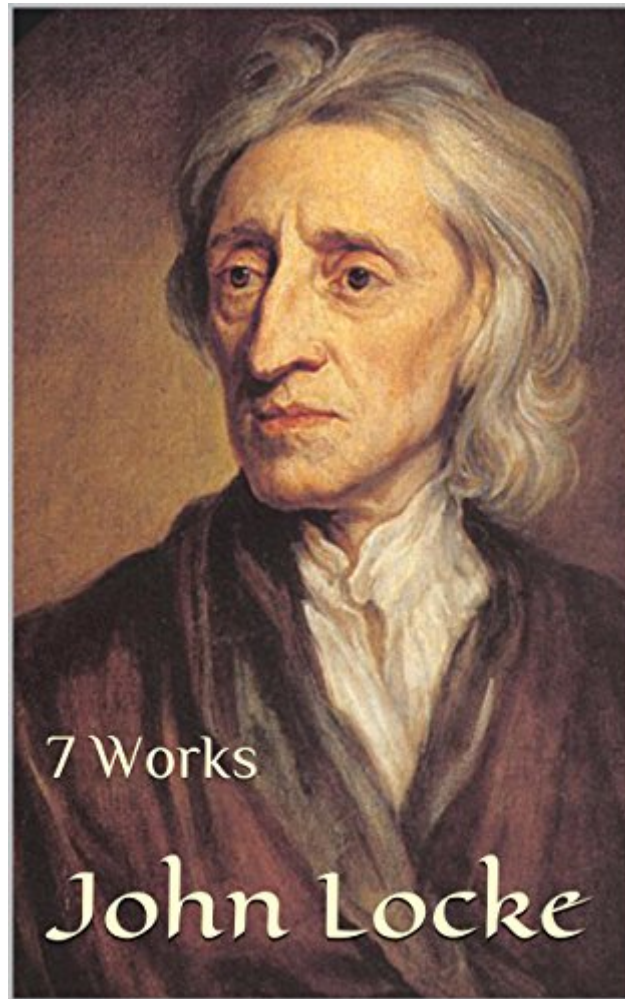




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John Locke: 7 Works

Took a long time to get through these works. If I could say anything bad, it is that he is very detailed and repeats ideas. But, I think I am an Empiricis like he is. So, I agree with his conclusions and am persuaded by his arguments. I have more reason to believe what I have long thought. The work on education is great, but it reflects the emphasis of men (gentlemen) getting the through education that was common at the time. I would recommend this to anyone wanting to have a historical perspective on modern empirical philosophy.

This is the source from which flowed many of the ideas now ensconced in the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States. Locke's works, especially his Second Treaties, are often referred to and mentioned in other historical volumes, but reading the material firsthand is like taking a deep breath of air straight from an oxygen bottle. Every patriot who desires to be properly prepared to resist the looming tyranny in our own country needs to read this volume.

Although the writing style is a bit dated, the ideas presented by Locke have stood the test of time. Consider skipping the constitution of the Carolinas.
