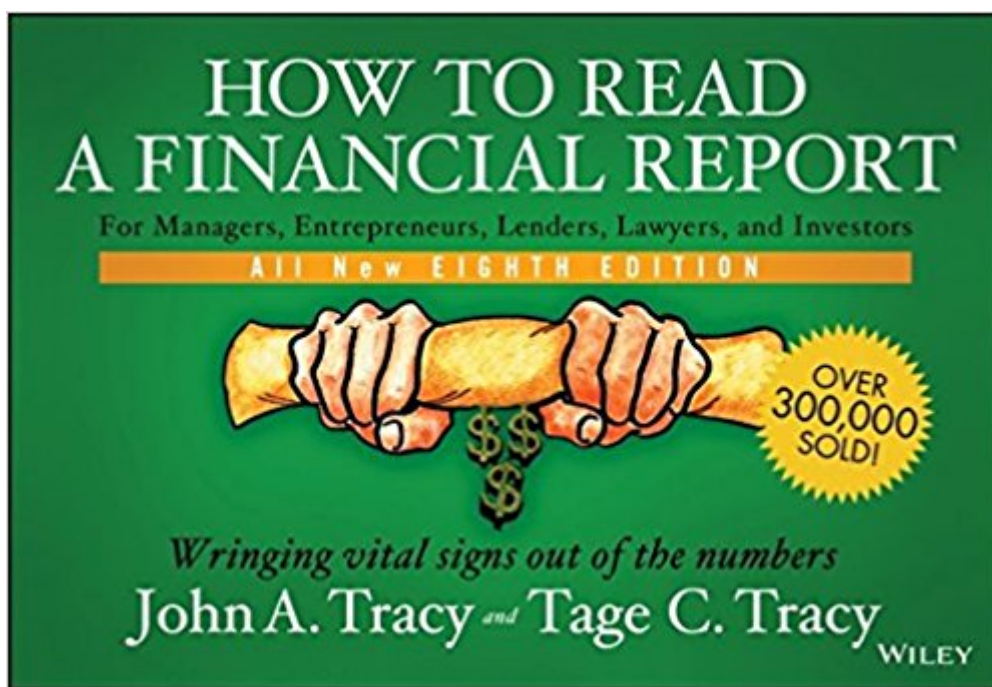




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How To Read A Financial Report: Wringing Vital Signs Out Of The Numbers

It's a good read. However, I was already acquainted with most of the knowledge being taught from accounting courses at universities. The most important lessons I learned are: the interconnections between the financial statements, what negative cash-flow means, how companies can massage their numbers and the meaning of a CPA's opinion. Not bad.

This book covers the relationship between the accounts in the financial report and touch a little bit on some possible manipulations in the accounts. The explanation given were simple and straightforward. However, this book may not be suitable for beginners that just learnt about financial report. It is intended for readers who have been familiar with financial reports and wanted to strengthen their concepts. I would recommend this book together with some other books to get the

full picture of what is going on.
