I never thought I would love another sector like I loved Four. Dallas and Lex, but I have to say that I am finding that I LOVE Sector one. It has taken a book or two. I am typically not into royalty and that genre of books so that is one preconceived notion I had about this spin off. My usual issues with that genre has NOT been present in this series. Anna is not your typical girl. She is a Rider and the first Rider ever and that does bring pressures not common to others. Deacon's past comes back to haunt him and he feels he should be punished for it. Anna disagrees. First, I must say I love Anna. She is a kick ass take no prisoners fluff ball. She has a heart of gold but she does what needs to be done. Deacon does wounded without being over the top. You can really relate to both characters and each seems "real". The love story is not the total focus but it feels so natural. You can feel Anna and Deacon slowly coming together even though the lust has always been present. The lust alone isn't enough for either character because of who they are |Riders. The love is built slowly. Naturally. Each is given experiences that helps them understand the Sector and each other better. This is the second book in this series. I highly recommend this to everyone.

I am completely captivated by this series. Deacon has had that mysterious vibe to him so I couldn't wait to peel back the layers. Of course this wouldn't be a Kit Rocha book if we didn't get yet another strong woman to pull our brooding hero into the light. This book is just as much about Deacon finally facing his violent past as it is Ana, who is trying to live up to her father's legacy as a Rider. She is also carrying the expectations for being the first woman in Gideon's Rider. What starts off as two people turning to each other for comfort slowly unfolds into a deep connection of trust, acceptance and deep passionate love. When

Deacon's past comes back to haunt him, what sacrifices will he make to find peace and keep the people in Sector One safe. How far will Ana go to keep Deacon from sacrificing himself. This hits all the right checkmarks on my must-read list: a hot sexy alpha hero, a heroine who kicks butt and sizzling hot chemistry that could ignite my kindle. This world is rich and vibrates with danger lurking around every corner along with a steamy plot that pulled me in from the first page and kept me transfixed until the very end.

Because I fell in love with Kit Rocha's BEYOND Series from the first time I read it, (yes, I've read it more than once...that's not the point), when it ended, I was afraid I'd have withdrawals when it ended....So, when they brought us their series, GIDEON'S RIDERS, the BEYOND Series spin-off, I couldn't wait for the first installment, ASHWIN, and, not surprisingly, I LOVED IT!! Each time Kit Rocha releases a new book, I think, "it can't possibly be as good as the previous ones." And each time, I'm proven wrong. I thoroughly enjoyed Deacon. Even though it is the second book in the Gideon's Riders series, I feel like this was our first true glimpse at the inside workings of Sector One. Ashwin (book 1 in the series), helped transition from the Beyond Series and Sector Four into the Riders series and Sector One, but Deacon immersed us into the Riders. I loved the dynamic between Deacon and Ana because they were two strong personalities who probably should have clashed, but instead, they came together and made each other stronger while still maintaining their individuality. I love that we not only see Ana's strength, but also her vulnerability. It was interesting, too, to see that vulnerability mirrored in Deacon, even though his perspective is so different from Ana's. The depth of the characters and the fact that they are human and flawed makes the story that much better. And, true to Kit Rocha form, even though this book is focused on Deacon and Ana, we also get to see small glimpses of the other characters and getting to know a little bit more about the new ones and even learning a little bit about what's going on with some of our favorites from the Beyond Series.
