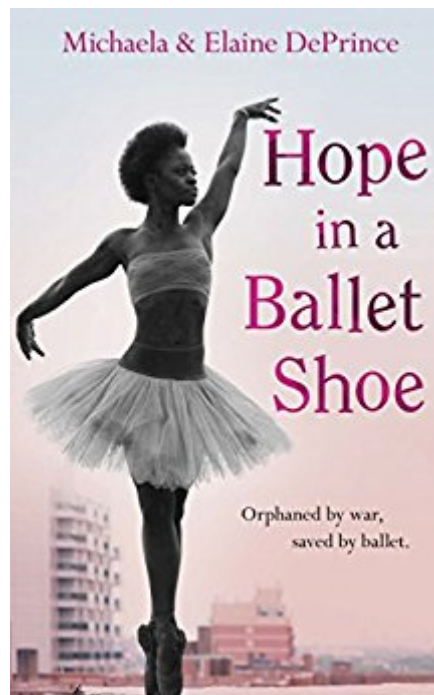

Fortunately, this is an incredibly strong and determined child who moves through girlhood into womanhood with fierceness and grace. It is also fortunate that she had contact with caring people at various critical moments and was adopted into an almost magically caring and loving family. My only regret is that the horrors of her own childhood make this story of dedication, determination and devotion unsuitable for young girls to read.
