


The book was found

PreS-Gr 2—Children are introduced to a lesser-known contemporary Midwestern American artist in this picture-book biography of Mary Nohl (1914–2001). A spare narrative allows the pictures to describe how, from childhood, Nohl's imagination soared as she explored the many interests that led her to combine found objects with cement to create fantastical creatures, eventually installed in the garden surrounding the Lake Michigan home she built with her father. World travels provided further inspiration for her non-traditional, sometimes primitive, art, ably represented here mostly in spreads that convey the scope and variety of Nohl's work. The illustrations combine watercolor with digital painting, collage, and vintage papers, resulting in a soft

palette and an uncomplicated, accessible drawing style. Children will delight in the whimsy of the art pieces and their placement in the garden as well as the participation of Mary's dogs, Sassafras and Basil, in the discovery process. An author's note, accompanied by two photographs, gives more detail about Nohl's life and the challenge of preserving her home and garden for public enjoyment. •Marie Orlando, formerly at Suffolk Cooperative Library System, Bellport, NY

In Mary's Garden is a picture book biography that will captivate kids. My children are 4, 6, 9, and 11, and they all love this book. You can't help but be drawn into Mary Nohl's world, and the way the

illustrations are done, it's like you're standing by her side and getting a glimpse into her imagination. My younger kids like the sculptures Mary creates, and my older kids like the idea of seeing creatures in the world around you, waiting to be built. The illustrations are a wonder in this book: layered and gorgeous, gauzy and fantastical bits of Mary's imagination combined with beautiful details of the items Mary has gathered to make her art. The thorough and in-depth author's note in the back gives more information about Mary Nohl, how she was viewed when she was alive, and what is happening with her house. I recommend this book if you're interested in showing kids an example of seeing art everywhere, how to make art from the objects around you, and how to be true to yourself and your creative vision.

What a delightful book! I'd never heard of this artist before, but the book inspired me to find out more about her. I think kids would enjoy the delightful illustrations, and the fascinating story of this artist's life and interesting works.
