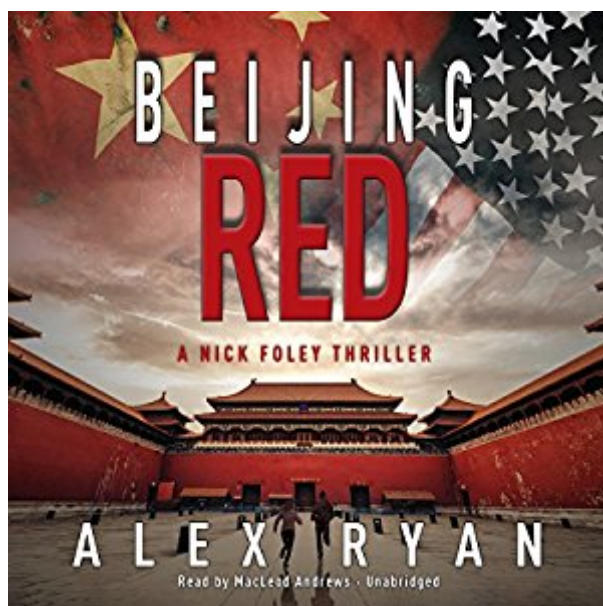


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Beijing Red: A Nick Foley Thriller, Book 1

The protagonist is an ex-SEAL (oh, yeah, I know...once a SEAL, always a SEAL--which is very true in this case), with a haunting past, who is excellent fodder for a long series. What a great new novel Alex Ryan created. Nick Foley is an interesting, and non-typical character. A former Navy Seal, haunted by his past, simply working in China on a water project, and he is drawn into a plot involving cutting edge nano-technology, and a bioterrorism plot like no other that threatens China, and then the world. Alex Ryan introduces us to several characters, some of which don't survive, but others we will see again in succeeding novels. I found this to be a superior first novel, and a fascinating character. Nick Foley is an interesting character, and quite atypical. Dr. Dash is a Chinese scientist, and the love interest, and again, not the typical character. Trust me, if you like geopolitical thrillers, this is an excellent read, and I will be counting the days until the second Nick Foley thriller.

A clever combination of factors leads to solving a bio-terrorism threat in China. The nanobots meant for curing disease become a potential tool for bad guys beyond China. Good guys from China and the USA combine talents and authority to track the trouble. Yes - clever.
