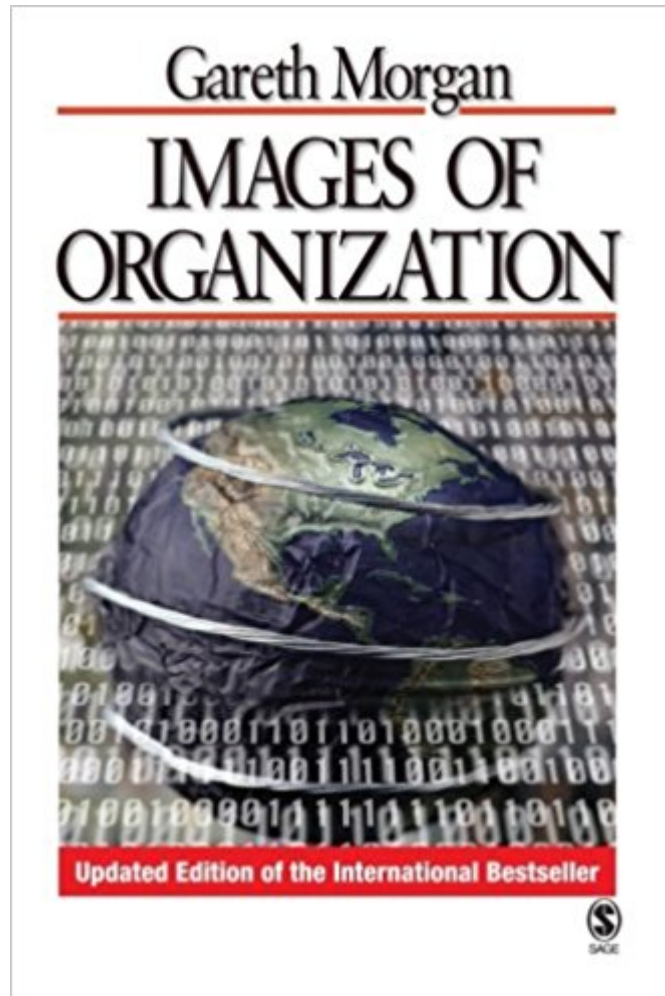

CH 2: Organizations as Machines CH 3: Organizations as Organisms CH 4: Organizations as Brains CH 5: Organizations as Cultures CH 6: Organizations as Political Systems CH 7: Organizations as Psychic Prisons These chapters represent the majority of the material relevant to organizational theory. Anyone who wants to learn more about organizational design should read this book
