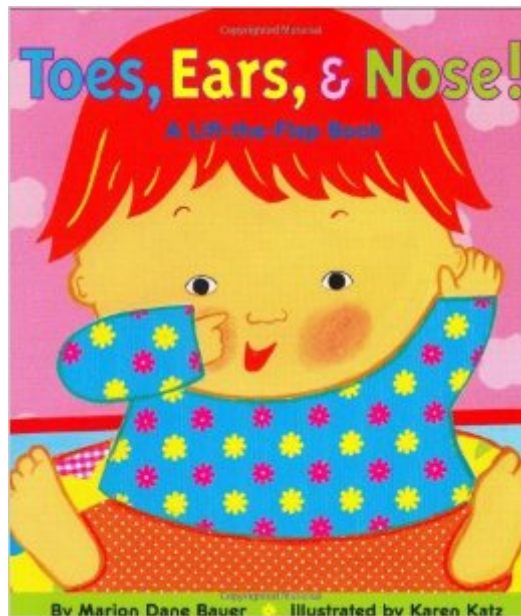

Little too advanced and not as interesting for my 13 month old. She will still lift the flaps but not a huge fan yet. I'm sure she will enjoy it more when she is a little older.

My 11 month old granddaughter is getting ready to start physical and occupational therapy to help her catch up after an illness and surgery. I was looking for books that would help her - not only to just entertain her but help with this process. This is a great book for any young child and I am thrilled to find it for my granddaughter.

My baby loves this. Although its a board book the flaps are thin cardboard which my 14 month old has ripped off several times. Not as sturdy as a regular board book. Having said that she really likes this book

this book is wonderful for introducing your babe to popular body parts...and the clothing that usually go with them where applicable. it highlights hands and gloves, feet and boots, ears and hat, scarf and nose, shirtsleeves and elbows, jeans and knees, coat and back and belly button, mouth and teeth and tongue, and glasses and eyes. it is manageable for the little hands to turn the sturdy board pages and raise the flaps (some flaps raise up and some fold down).educational, short, interesting and colourful..winner in my book!
