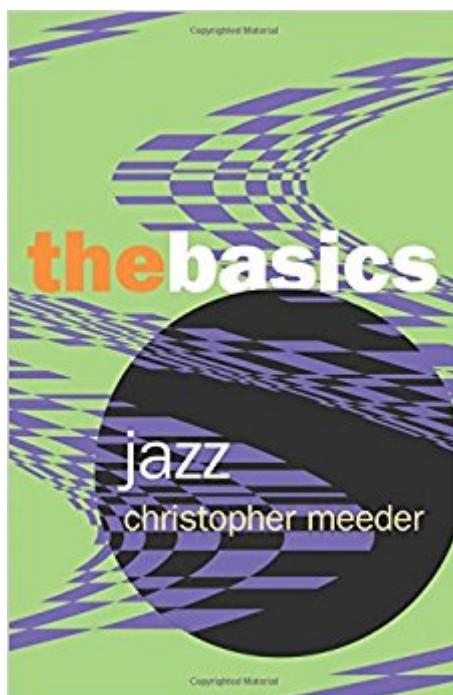

The book concludes with a list of the 100 essential recordings to own, along with a timeline and glossary.
