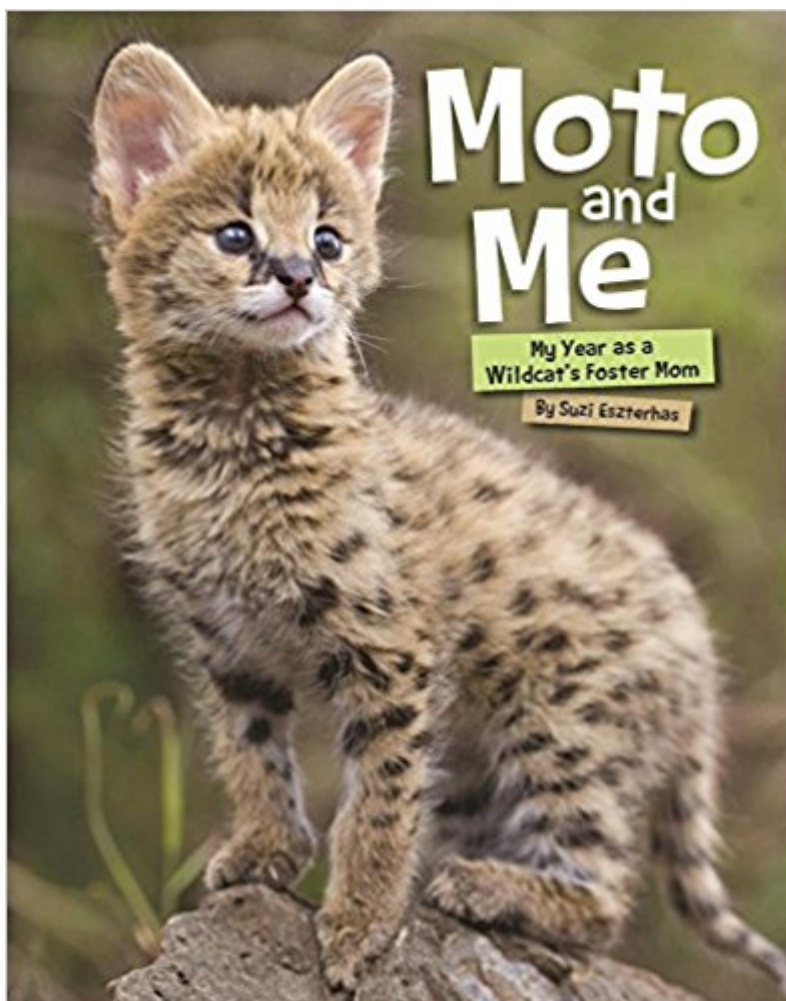

Moto And Me: My Year As A Wildcat's Foster Mom



Synopsis

Moto and Me tells the remarkable firsthand story of wildlife photographer Suzi Eszterhas's care for an orphaned baby serval—a small, spotted wildcat—in Kenya. When a grass fire separates the serval from his family, a ranger asks Suzi, who is living in a bush camp and is skilled with animals, to be the serval's foster mom. The book chronicles Suzi's tender care of Moto, including how she feeds, bathes, and plays with him, and helps him develop hunting skills. Her goal is to help him learn how to survive on his own in the wild. After 6 months, he is ready to leave—a difficult good-bye, but exactly what Suzi had worked for. Stunning photography illustrates this touching and rare wildlife rescue story.

My daughter told me that I needed to write a really long review about this book because it was so good! This book is an easy to read chapter book that my daughter and I very much enjoyed reading together. My daughter is crazy about animal stories especially cats so this book was a great hit. As you might expect since this book was written by a wildlife photographer, the pictures are amazing! You really want to reach out your hand and pet Moto. My daughter and I neither one knew much about servals when we started and we were shocked to learn that serval kittens do not know how to go to the bathroom on their own. "When their mom cleans their bottoms, the feel of her warm, wet tongue tells their bodies that it is time to go." We both heartily agreed that we are glad this is not the case for human babies!! I remember watching Born Free when I was little and I was sad when the Adamsons had to leave Elsa, so I was a little worried I would feel a bit sad at the end of this book. Actually, Eszterhas does a great job of making the end feel triumphant rather than sad. Eszterhas has taken a lot of amazing photographs of wild animals and their babies and we enjoyed looking online at those pictures as well. We also learned some about endangered animals online including the pangolin which I had never even heard of previously! Altogether this book is a winner!

I'm going to give you three good reasons why you're going to go buy this book. 1. A portion of the royalties from sales of the book will be donated to the Mara Conservancy to help protect Moto's home. 2. LOOK AT THAT FACE. 3. LOOK AT IT. Now that I've clearly and concisely argued my

point. This book is amazing. Told quickly and effectively, as all children's nonfiction needs to be, it's the story of the world's most flippin' adorable baby serval, and the year Suzi Eszterhas spent fostering him while taking photographs in the wild in Kenya. The story of Mama Serval having to leave her baby behind is literally like two paragraphs and I was tearing up. I'm so soft. Maybe if I couldn't see the baby face, it would've been easier to handle. So much can be learned about wild animals in these few pages, and it's just such a sweet, fun story. Kids will be wondering about Moto, running in the wild and making new adorable fluffy faced bitey babies.

Moto, is a wildcat, a Serval, from Kenya. When he is found at approximately 2 weeks old by tourists, he is given to the author Suzi Eszterhas, a wildlife photographer. She is asked by the Rangers to foster the kitten. Her goal is to look after him, but to assist him to become independent so he can survive in the wild. There are beautiful photographs that add to the narrative of what Suzi does to help Moto learn to be an independent adult. There is a section at the back that gives facts about servals. I had never heard of this type of cat before, so found the information fascinating. It is important that the book teaches that fostering a wild animal is not the same as having a pet. That is something that children need to learn. This book would be a great addition to a school library and could be used in different ways. The publisher generously provided me with a copy of this book via Netgalley.

I'm always on the lookout for non-fiction books about animals to share with the students in the 2nd grade classroom where I work. They are voracious readers in general but they seem to especially enjoy reading about animals, rescues in particular. I wish I'd received a print review copy just so I could have shared this one with them, without a doubt this would be a favorite. Moto is so cute and his story shows how important it is for baby animals to be with their mothers. I also found it to be an exciting way to learn how much work caring for an animal is as well as what happens when a wild animal is rehabilitated and able to return to their natural life cycle. life to help a wild animal to return to the wild. Told in simple to read and follow along text. Young readers can enjoy sharing Suzi's year long adventure teaching Moto how to survive in the wild with their family and friends. The numerous photographs enhance young readers enjoyment of this delightfully fun read. My rating of Moto and Me is 4.5 out of 5 stars.

Moto and Me, a personal inside look at an animal rescuer and the Serval that she raises to return to the wild is the first book by Suzi Eszterhas for me to have read. To say it is wonderful or amazing is an understatement. The text and illustrations give the reader insight not only to the Serval cat but to the author as well. It conveys the feelings of a foster animal mom with the "wildness" of the African Masai Mara's savanna. Fantastic photographs with open, honest details that would delight young readers as well as older; it is simply beautifully done. As having thirty years in elementary education, I believe this is one of the best children's animal nonfiction books I have ever read. The publisher through Net Galley provided a copy.

I knew Ms. Eszterhas through her wonderful photos. I never guessed her voice would shine just as brightly...but it does. This book has wow-power--an appealing story with visual cuteness galore.
