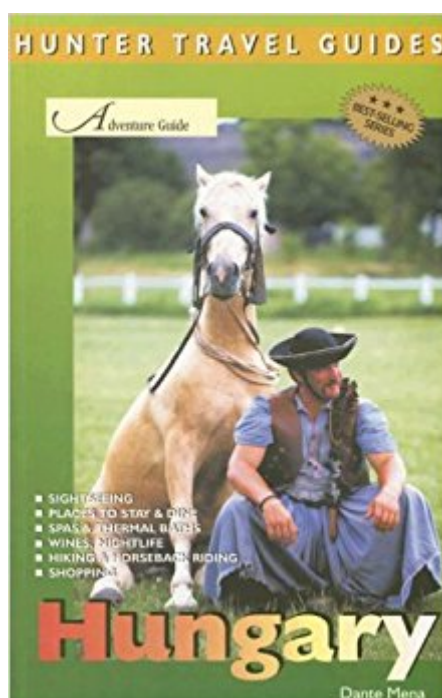


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Hungary Adventure Guide (Adventure Guide To Hungary & The Czech & Slovak Republic)
