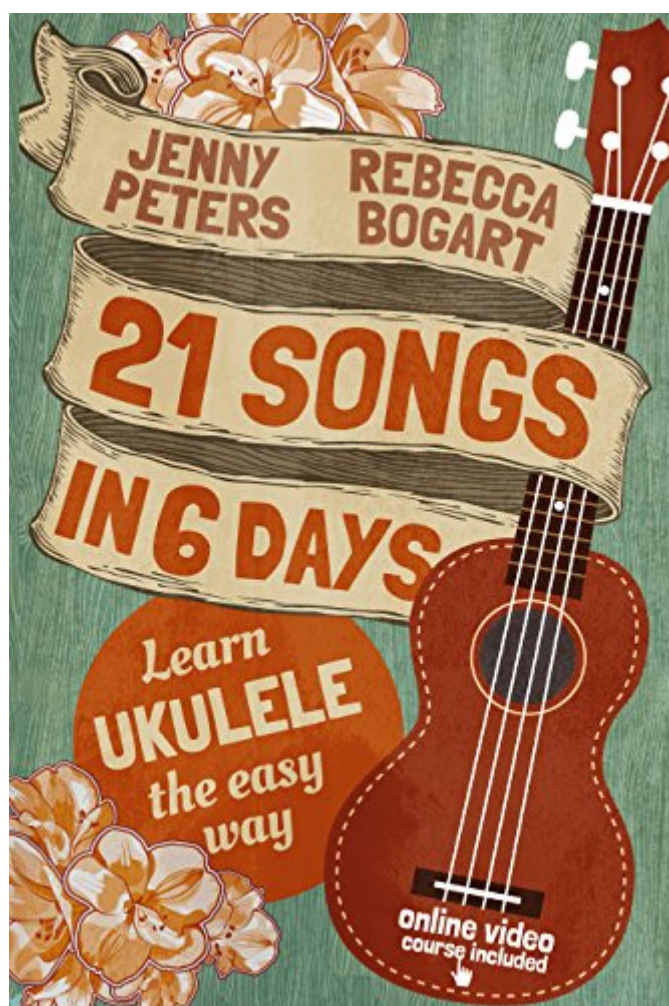

I hate to be the dissenting voice but this did not work for me at all. This is partially my fault, as I didn't review the book description carefully enough and as a result I didn't realize that MOST of the useful content would come via daily e-mails. I found this process tedious and also then it made it impossible to work ahead if I had a chunk of time. I spend enough time checking e-mail, I don't want to have to check my e-mail to get my lesson or review an old one. This is supposed to be fun. I think there are much better ways to do this. Also, the placement of the camera so far away from the players made it difficult to see the fretwork/strumming. So yes, it is absolutely my fault for not reviewing the information closely enough but for those considering a purchase, if you travel a lot, don't want to have to check your e-mail everyday for the next lesson or to review one you already completed, then keep that in mind when making your selection.

When I downloaded the Kindle book, I wasn't sure what to expect. I read it and signed up for a message sent to my e-mail (which I highly recommend). The book is easy and relatively simple instructions to follow..Another pro, when you send the authors an e-mail, they actually respond! If you have any questions, they will respond, not a robot! I am fairly new to the ukulele (a little over a year) but have played piano and guitar for over 30 years. My musical background is comprehensive. I am also a private teacher of these instruments. I have looked at many, many "method" books for all 3 of these instruments over the past several years. When I started to read through this book, I was very pleasantly surprised. I was very happy to see how much was covered in a short amount of pages and that it was covered in a very logical order. A lot of the method books I have seen are not logical in my opinion. Not only does this book cover the concepts in a logical sequence, but each concept and techniques from the chapter before are reviewed before moving into the new concepts and technique. Having the videos examples for each of the songs and techniques and concepts was a very smart addition to the book. I have to think hard on how many standard method books actually have videos to watch for what they explain in their books. It is impressive that you are able to learn 21 songs in just 6 days, using just 5 basic chords. The suggested strum rhythms are logically suggested for the song rhythms. The chord changes are illustrated uniquely with font changes in the words for each change, but I thought this

was a bit confusing, as I am used to having chords above the words for each line, so that I know what is next. With this method, I have to think a little harder on what chord is next and if I forget what chord goes with what font, I have to stop and check, whereas with a chord chart I can keep going. That's really my only "dissatisfaction" with this book, and didn't warrant affecting the rating. The basic introductory items on getting setup to play with getting an instrument, etc., was comprehensively covered, so you can get ready to start right away. Overall I thought this was very well done, a very fast read, and all explained in very simple ways rather than trying to understand a lot of technical and theoretical jargon. I am looking forward to seeing the next one!

I recently acquired a ukulele, and was looking for a good beginner's book. I found this one, and I'm glad I did. It really helped get me started. It's also a lot of fun--if you buy the book and get on the mailing list, you receive video lessons (these are a hoot because they are so casually presented, which makes them very non-intimidating). From time to time, the authors also send free additional lessons, and these tend to be a bit more sophisticated than the simpler songs presented in the book. The book is basic enough that a first-time player should be able to learn a lot from it. I enjoy the ongoing emails from the authors, the video lessons, and the free additional song lessons. The additional materials are really important if you want to get the most out of the book. I highly recommend this book for beginning ukelele players.

Still learning but the book is very helpful.

I picked up a Ukulele on my first trip to Maui a few months ago. With the help of this Kindle book, I was able to play more than 21 songs on the Ukulele in 6 days. It does help greatly if you have computer access to watch and listen the video links and play-alongs. You don't need to have a musical background, or even musical talent. You just need a desire to learn to play, and the willingness to set aside a small portion of the day to practice.

The songs are extremely simplistic. I learned more from a 5th grade music book in the first 5 pages than this entire book. Maybe this book doesn't market itself well enough as a children's book.

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
