

Overall, I enjoyed this book and thought that it was written in an entertaining and gritty style. My one complaint is this: Earley says that he picked a handful of officials/inmates to focus on. I would have liked to seen a wider range of personalities explored in depth. The three or four inmates that he focused on were all white, and to a certain extent cut from the same cloth. Given the racial tension that simmered between the lines of his account, I would have liked heard from a black inmate or one of the Cuban detainees. I realize that this probably wasn't possible; in the world that Earley describes I'm sure that he himself was segregated, and spending time with non-white inmates might not have been practical. But I would have enjoyed the book more if he had been able to overcome this obstacle.
