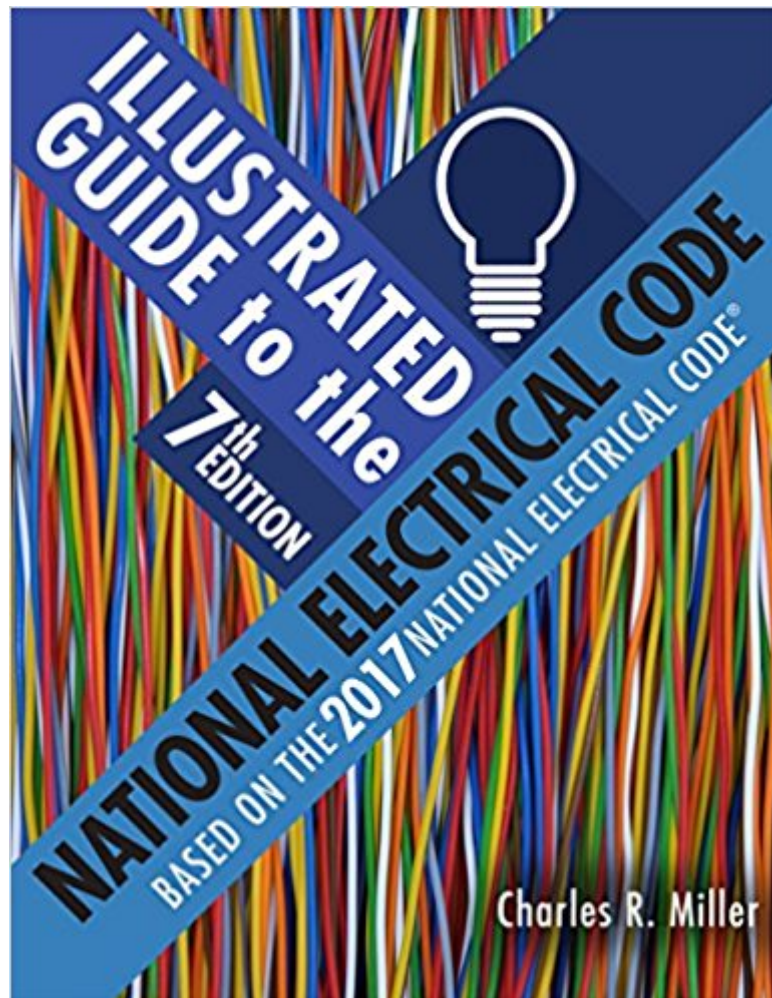

On a job site it is great since it is indexed by application (IE if you are doing commercial work just flip to the commercial section). if you are looking up a reference (such as notes from an inspector or on prints) it is useless unless you already know what that NEC number is.
